

Todd English's Plaza Food Hall Opens in New York

Although it just opened its door on June 4, foodies are already flocking to the much-anticipated Plaza Food Hall by [Todd English](#).

Located on the concourse level of [the Plaza](#), New York's most iconic hotel, the fancy new food court was designed by the hospitality design honchos at [Jeffrey Beers International](#). The 5,400-square-foot European-inspired marketplace features its own entrance on Fifth Avenue and 59th streets and boasts eight culinary stations including a grill, a bakery, a cheese and charcuterie counter, a pizza counter, and wine, dumpling, sushi, and oyster bars.

Jeffrey Beers, who had collaborated with celeb chef English on one of the latter's signature Olives restaurants and is himself known for his work on the [Fontainebleau](#), [China Grill](#), [Japonais](#), and [DB Bistro Moderne](#), went with an opulent palette of materials to match the hotel's high-end history but with an updated look to lure in new visitors.
